- ☐ Coaches email to players introducing yourself
- ☐ Confirm that all players have their uniforms
 - Uniform pickup night will be August 29th, time and location TBD

- ☐ Review roster and confirm player numbers are correct in sports manager
 - Rosters need to be accurate, you will need to provide two copies of your roster to the referee for each game you play.
 - You can view and edit jersey numbers when you log into sports manager, click on the manage roster tab and then click on the player.

 - Targeting August 31st for the meeting
 - Time and location will be communicated in a separate email.

CORI Process

 - Click on Affinity Adult / CORI Registration Portal on ShareView link
 - Complete application process
 - Coach will receive email confirmation from the site.
 - Coach should email Paul Sateriale the form and a copy of their license.
 - Paul will monitor the site and once the Cori is approved he will notify you and create your lanyard.

- ☐ Challenger practice confirmed
 - Schedule to be released by August 18th
 - Communicate schedule to players

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- Coaches practice confirmed
 - Practices can start the week of August 21st
 - Practice schedule to be opened by August 19th
 - How to schedule your practice
 - Log into sports manager under coach
 - Select the team you are coaching
 - Click on the “manage roster” tab
 - Click on the “add/edit practices” tab
 - Do not book any practices on Marvin / Rotary Fields – these are reserved for Challenger and your Challenger practice time will be entered for you
 - Click on the day and field (if multiple fields) you wish to schedule your practice on.
 - You will be prompted to accept recurring practices, accept
 - Time of practices default to system settings, which are the earliest times our permit will allow. You cannot schedule your practice earlier unless our permit allows.
 - If you want to change the start of your practice to a later time, click on the link to your team and your practice schedule for each day will appear.
 - Edit start times as needed.
 - We are expecting to have access to the fields starting August 21st, a separate email will be sent confirming this.

 - Communicate schedule to players
- Obtain player and coach ids
 - Player cards, coaching cards and lanyards will be available for pick up by September 4th. A separate communication from Paul is forth coming as to when they will be ready for pick up and where.
 - Player cards (U12 & U14 only, U10s do not require player cards)
 - Lanyards and ids are required for all Head and Asst Coaches

 - Game schedule should be available by September 1st
 - Please remember there may be adjustments to game times and locations after September 1st, please review and confirm games with opposing coach each week.

 - F license can be taken on line at a cost of \$25 dollars. BYSA will reimburse all applicants the cost of the course.
