

Hi,

Below are a few items to go over as we begin our season.

Travel game rescheduling is done by the following procedure only:

- a. Contact visiting coach and determine a suitable day and time (your practice time is a good choice and possibly a few dates in case your number one isn't available)
- b. Reserve the field with field scheduler (Rich Thomas) and field director (Me). They will inform your league director (Tom Casey for boys, Bryan Drake for girls) of the preferred date and time. If the time is available, Tom and Bryan will schedule with MAYS. It is not officially rescheduled until you get a confirmation email. Make up games take precedence over practices but not over regularly scheduled games. Don't be surprised if your weekly practice gets bumped for a makeup, it happens to everyone. You can't cancel for any old reason. Check with your directors before hand and they can tell you if it's a valid reason.
- c. The reschedule must be done within two weeks of the cancellation and must be played within four weeks of the regularly scheduled game or it will be forfeited.

Always check your email before heading to a game for any updates to the schedule.

In Town rescheduling procedures:

Rich Thomas, and myself handle rescheduling for in town. You should also let your division director know. If you don't know who your director is, they are listed on the sports manager and Facebook sites. Please do not cancel your own game. If you don't hear from me due to weather or field related problems, the game is on. If bad weather occurs while the game is being played then the ref will make a determination. Obviously, if there is lightning then please vacate the fields and find a safe place.

Other field related items:

Parking will be tight in the Bond Rd lot. There is additional parking across the street at the beagle club. If you do use their lot, please pull in to the left and park in the grassy field. Please do not park in front of the beagle club. Lastly, do not park in the baseball lot at all unless you hear otherwise

from a CYS board member.

Please try and keep all trash off the fields and in the trash receptacles. During practice time, if you use goals for shooting drills or scrimmages, move them to a new location, either to the side or forward of their game position. We'd like to try and minimize field wear in front of the goal area to keep it better for game time. If you do move a goal, please put it back into place after practicing. **This goes for all goals except the U14/HS goals. Please do not move these goals at all.** The U12 goals have new wheel hardware, which will make moving the goals easier. Please try and keep the hardware with the goals. If you notice any set missing, let me know as soon as possible and I will fix it. Lastly, please make sure the last team out closes and locks the gate. This is very important.

Please let me know if there are any field related problems and I will try and correct it.
