We have had MANY issues this season so far and we are only into the third week of the season! Please forward this email to your coaches, especially those who did not come to the meeting at the beginning of the season.

1. No pass cards = NO GAME!!! Coaches should not be asking referees to waive this or to look at their driver's license. All coaches need to have their pass cards;
2. No pictures on the pass card = **NO GAME** for that player/coach;
3. Teams need to SHOW UP to their scheduled games. We had MANY games that referees went to the field only to find no teams or only one team. Especially if you ask for a game move due to a field being unavailable for whatever reason you need to show up or it is a forfeit;
5. Coaches need to supply **TWO** rosters for their team for every game. This should not be an issue, all coaches can login and print their own rosters;
6. Schedule changes - **No additional requests are being accepted at this time.** Remember "vacation" is not an acceptable reason for a schedule change and all changes need to be approved by the league president;
7. If you have a schedule change from a previous game please make sure the opposing coach is aware of the schedule change; and
8. Lastly, a reminder of the **Zero Tolerance Policy**. Many of the referees are young, please remember they are someone's sons and daughters and we are sure you would not tolerate it if someone was yelling at your son or daughter the way some coaches and parents have been treated them this season.

We appreciate your commitment to the children and we hope that everyone has fun this season! The MAYS Board is doing all we can, as volunteers ourselves, to make it the best possible place to play for your kids.
