COACHING INFORMATION

Effective for the 2010 season and beyond, background checks through MorphoTrak (formerly Sagem Morpho) will be **mandatory** for all coaches ***in addition to attending the Rutgers Coaches Certification session.*** Please allow additional time at registration to sign-up for this process, at no charge. Sign-up for the background check will include submission of the coach's Social Security Number directly, and confidentially, to MorphoTrak. TRAVEL PRACTICES, GAMES AND FEE

Future practice/game dates, sites, and times will be announced after all boy and girl travel teams are selected and at the coach's discretion. Players selected for their travel team will be required to pay an additional fee of \$50.00. The travel basketball fee is used towards league and tournament registration. **New** players will need to purchase a uniform as well.

Travel basketball players will be required to participate in their respective intramural basketball league. If a player chooses not to participate in the intramural basketball league, the player will **not** be allowed to participate in the travel basketball program.

BOYS INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL

1st and 2nd grades – This instructional program will begin **Saturday, January 4, 2014** at the High School A-Gym or Fair Lawn Community Center. 5th and 6th grades – This program starts **Saturday, December 7** at the TJ Middle School Gym. This program will run on Saturday afternoon between the hours of 12 p.m. – 4 p.m. All children are placed on a team and coaches will call with starting times.

7th and 8th grades – This program will start **Saturday, December 7** at the TJ Middle School Gym. This program will run on Saturday mornings between the hours of 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. All children are placed on a team and coaches will call with starting times.

FAIR LAWN ALL SPORTS CODE OF CONDUCT

The Fair Lawn All- Sports Board of Directors requires that a parent or guardian of each participant sign below. This acknowledges that they have read this sheet, understand it, and agree to conform to these rules.

1. It is understood that there will be **no** arguing with officials at any time.
2. It is understood that profane or abusive language will not be tolerated at any time while participating in an All-Sports activity.
3. It is understood that fighting will not be tolerated at any time while participating in an All- Sports activity.
4. It is agreed that I will conduct myself in a proper manner.

Violations of any of the above will lead to automatic ejection from a contest. In an attempt to ensure that our coaches, parents, and players conduct themselves with proper behavior and are able to enjoy participation in All- Sports activities, we have created the following guidelines:

Players

- a. If a player is ejected from a game-the All-Sports Sportsmanship Committee will issue a warning to the player and the committee has the power to suspend the player from further games.
- b. If a player is ejected a second time during that season the Sportsmanship Committee will issue a warning to the player, but the committee will consider that this is the second offense and will in all likelihood issue a much harsher ruling depending on the specific circumstances of the ejection.

Coaches

- a. If a coach is ejected from a game-the Sportsmanship Committee will automatically suspend the coach for the next scheduled game and the committee may issue a harsher ruling depending on the circumstances of the ejection.
- b. If a coach is ejected a second time during that season- the Sportsmanship Committee will issue a minimum of a two game suspension and again has the authority to issue a harsher ruling depending on the circumstances.
- c. Should a coach **instigate** a physical situation or a fight - the Sportsmanship Committee will automatically suspend that coach for the balance of that season and again has the authority to issue a harsher ruling depending on the circumstances.

Parents/Relatives

- a. If parents or relatives of a player are abusive or cause a disruptive situation, we would ask our coaches to first attempt to stop this behavior. Should this behavior continue, the program chairperson will attempt to modify the behavior. Should the problem continue unabated, the Sportsmanship Committee will correspond to the individual or individuals and advise them that they will not be permitted to attend any more contests, and if they do attend, their child or children will not be able to participate in those contests.

There will be no refunds for dismissals from any programs for sportsmanship violations. Fair Lawn All-Sports hopes that none of the above penalties will have to be implemented, but rather that our participants, coaches, and fans will enjoy their season and let our players play and learn under the proper guidelines and conditions.

Fair Lawn All – Sports Parent waiver and consent:
