

FAIR LAWN ALL-SPORTS INTRAMURAL AND TRAVEL BASKETBALL INFORMATION

BOYS INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL

1st and 2nd grades – This instructional program will begin **Saturday, January 5, 2019** at the Fair Lawn Community Center. This program will run on Saturday afternoon between the hours of 11:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Children will be placed on a team and parent(s) will be contacted with start times. Children will receive fundamental instruction from a basketball training group.

3rd and 4th grades – This program starts **Friday, November 30** at the Radburn School and Forrest School. This program will run on Friday evenings between the hours of 6:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m. Children will be evaluated and drafted on a team. Coaches will contact child's parent(s) with starting times once teams are set.

5th and 6th grades – This program starts **Saturday, December 1** at TJ Middle School. This program will run on Saturday afternoon between the hours of 1:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Children will be evaluated and drafted on a team. Coaches will contact child's parent(s) with starting times once teams are set.

7th and 8th grades – This program will start **Saturday, December 1** at TJ Middle School. This program will run on Saturday mornings between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Children will be evaluated and drafted on a team. Coaches will contact child's parent(s) with starting times once teams are set.

GIRLS INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL

1st and 2nd grades – This instructional program will begin **Saturday, January 5, 2019** at the Fair Lawn Community Center. This program will run on Saturday afternoon between the hours of 2:30 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. Children will be placed on a team and parent(s) will be contacted with start times. Children will receive fundamental instruction from a basketball training group.

3rd and 4th grades – This program starts **Friday, November 30** at Westmoreland School, Lyncrest School and Milnes School. This program will run on Friday evenings between the hours of 7:00 p.m. – 9:30 p.m. Children will be drafted on a team according to school roster. Coaches will contact child's parent(s) with starting times once teams are set.

5th and 6th grades – This program starts **Thursday, November 29** at TJ Middle School. This program will run on Thursday evening between the hours of 6:00 p.m. – 9:45 p.m. Children will be evaluated and drafted on a team. Coaches will contact child's parent(s) with starting times once teams are set.

7th and 8th grades – This program will start **Thursday, November 29** at the Radburn Elementary School Gym. This program will run on Thursday evenings between the hours of 6:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m. Children will be evaluated and drafted on a team. Coaches will contact child's parent(s) with starting times once teams are set.

BOYS TRAVEL BASKETBALL

The Fair Lawn All-Sports Boys Basketball program (Grades 3 – 8) participates in Bergen Travel Basketball League (BTBL) during the season. In addition to league play, teams will enter in various tournaments throughout the season.

GIRLS TRAVEL BASKETBALL

The Fair Lawn All-Sports Girls Basketball program (Grades 3 – 8) participates in North/West Bergen/Passaic Basketball (NWBP) League during the season. The 6th, 7th and 8th grade teams will also participate in the Bergen Travel Basketball League (BTBL). In addition to league play, teams will enter in various tournaments throughout the season.

TRAVEL BASKETBALL TRYOUTS

Travel basketball tryout dates and information will be posted on the Fair Lawn All-Sports website www.flallsports.org. Attendance is only required at one of the two tryouts; however, it is strongly recommended that those trying out attend both tryouts that have been scheduled for their level of play. Anyone who cannot attend either of the two scheduled tryouts will then need to make arrangements for their own individual tryout.

The Fair Lawn travel basketball program is competitive and is meant for children that have a strong interest in the sport and want to compete at a high level. All kids will be coached equally, but the league has no playing time requirements and playing time will likely not be equal. Please keep in mind there will be cuts and we therefore want to make sure all are able and willing to fully commit to their travel teams before cuts are made.

TRAVEL PRACTICES, GAMES AND FEE

Future practice/game dates, sites, and times will be announced after all boy and girl travel teams are selected and at the coach's discretion. Players selected for their travel team will be required to pay an additional fee of **\$100.00**. The travel basketball fee is used towards league and tournament registration. **New** players will need to purchase a uniform as well. Travel basketball players will be required to participate in their respective intramural basketball league. If a player chooses not to participate in the intramural basketball league, the player will **not** be allowed to participate in the travel basketball program.

COACHING INFORMATION

Volunteer coaches are NEEDED for all intramural levels. NO experience is necessary. All information concerning coaching will be available at registration. Please see the coordinator for your grade level for information. Background checks through **Little League International (First Advantage)** will be mandatory for all coaches in addition to attending the Rutgers Coaches Certification session. Please allow additional time at registration to sign-up for this process, at no charge. Sign-up for the background check will include submission of the coach's social security and driver's license number.
