Fair Lawn All-Sports in conjunction with Little League International and with agreement of the Boro of Fair Lawn is updating our background check policy. We had been subject to fingerprinting when becoming a new coach and participation in the Rutgers Certification program. Currently, the re-fingerprinting was to be done every 5 years.

The new policy will be for new coaches to be fingerprinted and go through the Rutgers Certification; however, now re-fingerprinting is every 7 years. In other words if you were fingerprinted in 2010, you will not need to go through that process again until 2017.

Also all coaches must fill out the attached form and this must be done each year you are coaching. The form, which is attached, contains personal information and we do not want that to be sent via e-mail. Instead the form must be handed in by the coach, with a photo ID to confirm the identity of the coach. The form will be entered into the First Advantage data base which is the contractor designated by Little League to conduct the searches. The information will only be entered by a Fair Lawn Little League Safety officer and then the form will be shredded. This must be done in order to coach in Fair Lawn.

We will be having designated times to drop off the forms all of which must be done by March 31, 2015 for all spring season coaches. The following dates have been established prior to March 31, 2015

Thursday March 19, 2015 at the Community Center from 6:30 pm-7:30pm

Monday March 23, 2015 at the Community Center from 6:30 pm-7:30pm
