



FSS works to challenge each individual at the level and with the conditions that are appropriate for him or her.

Players explore demonstrated, basic techniques. Skills covered include attack dribbling to get beyond a defender, juggling, passing, methods of possession, principles of defending, shooting, goal scoring and mastery of the ball.

Players are grouped into teams, which compete against one another during the week. The intra-camp league is designed to add a fun, competitive environment which allows all players an opportunity to demonstrate their own progress with new and mastered skills.

Homework assignments are intended to broaden each players awareness of soccer in the community, nation, and world. At the same time, we hope to illustrate a connection between what is covered in class with real examples.

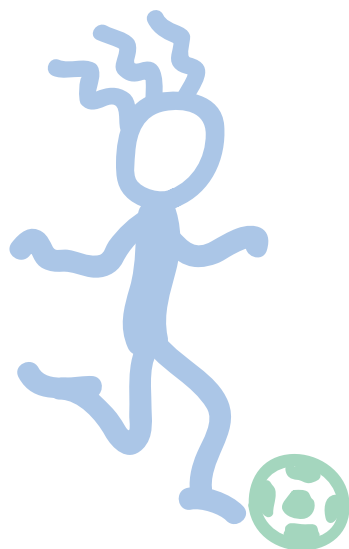
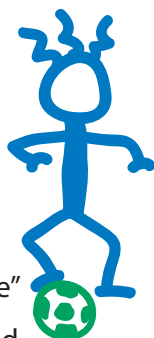
