Proposed Improvements...

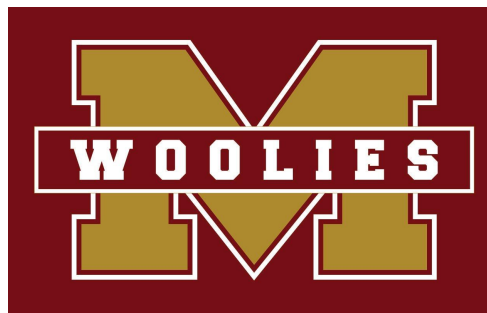
- New track and field centrally located within the same footprint as the current facility
- New spectator seating with pressbox
- New concessions/amenities building
- New athletic lighting system
- New softball facility
- New parking area to the south and west
- New single gate access point

Master Plan Summary...

- A new, state-of-the-art, NFHS compliant track and field facility
- A synthetic rectangular surface installed inside of the new oval track
- A new synthetic softball facility will also be addressed on the High School Campus
- The facility will allow for both doubleheader contests as well as practice while competition is occurring
- Will allow us to host postseason and tournament events, increasing exposure and fundraising opportunities
- Total project cost is proposed at \$4,950,834
- This averages .26 cents per \$1,000 of the assessed value of your home

Why are athletic field improvements needed?

- Scheduling conflicts since baseball is located within the track
- Track is only 5 lanes and restricts ability to run regional track events
- Non-symmetrical, non-uniform "D" shaped track layout has very "tight" radii and not suitable for hosting league/state meets.
- Field is currently poorly drained, especially in the outfield/football field area.
- Football goal posts are located inside the baseball field complex
- Limited athletic surfaces: Fall practices occur on the outfield of the HS softball field
