Proposal to change the MYSL Consitution

Presented to a Special General Meeting of the MYSL

I move that we change Article 4 of the MYSL Constitution in the following manner:

Existing Language:

The election of Directors according to the preceding schedule shall occur at the Annual General Meeting by means of paper ballot. The unfilled tenure of any vacated position(s) shall be filled at the next Annual General Meeting by means of paper ballot. Each member organization shall designate one individual to vote on its behalf at the Annual General Meeting.

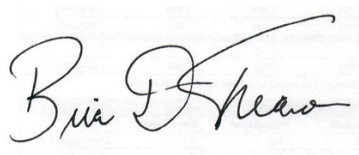
Proposed Change:

The election of Directors according to the preceding schedule shall occur at the Annual General Meeting by means of a ballot. The unfilled tenure of any vacated position(s) shall be filled at the next General Meeting by means of a ballot. Each member organization shall designate one individual to vote for Directors on its behalf at any General Meeting. Each designated individual shall have a number of votes equal to the number of votes allocated to his or her member organization per Article 7 of this Constitution.

Summary of changes:

- Strike the word “paper” before the word “ballot” wherever it appears. Also change “ballot” to “a ballot” wherever it appears.
- Strike the word Annual from the second sentence.
- Strike the words “the Annual” from the third sentence and replace with the word “any”
- Insert the words “for Directors” between the words “vote” and “on” in the last sentence.
- Insert the sentence “Each designated individual shall have a number of votes equal to the number of votes allocated to his or her member organization per Article 7 of this Constitution.” after the last sentence in the above cited existing language.
