

Games on Gillette Stadium Field
Mansfield Youth Soccer & Attleboro Youth Soccer
Revolution vs. Philadelphia Union
Saturday, June 28th, 7:30 PM

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

- When to Arrive: Make sure to leave plenty of time to arrive at the stadium and to walk over to the field and sign in. **There is no rescheduling if you are late or miss your game.** The Revolution staff will need to set up the field for warm-ups immediately after we are done with the final games at 5:20 PM.
 - It is about a 5-10 minute walk from Lot 6A and 6B to the check-in area.
- Parking/Tailgating:
 - Please make sure that you have your parking pass printed and visible on your dashboard. If you do not have a pass, you will not be allowed into Lot 6A or 6B.
 - Lots 6A and 6B are reserved for Mansfield Youth Soccer and Attleboro Youth Soccer, respectively, and will open at 2:00pm. **THERE WILL BE NO TAILGATING UNTIL 4:30PM.** (Tailgating includes: open fires and grills, consumption of alcohol, setting up food tables, etc.)
 - *****You may park in your reserved parking lot (6A for Mansfield, 6B for Attleboro) for all activities during the day (Games on Gillette Stadium field, tailgating (even though tailgating does not officially start until 4:30PM), and the Revolution game). You should not need to move your car during the day.
 - Feel free to bring grills, food and games to the tailgate
- Where to check in/get information:
 - Check-in for your game on Gillette field will be at the **NRG Plaza entrance** (marked on map at Patriot Place gate, which is under the walking bridge on the concourse). There will be 2 check-in tables set up where teams/spectators will show their tickets, hand in their waiver, and players/coaches will get a wristband to gain access to the field. *****ONLY PLAYERS AND COACHES WILL BE ALLOWED OUT ONTO THE FIELD******
 - Players and coaches on the field must fill out the waiver (in attached e-mail) to gain access to the field.

- From the check in table, parents and spectators will be directed into the designated sections of Gillette Stadium.
- EVERYONE will need a ticket to enter the stadium, although none will be scanned upon entrance. There are a few exceptions in which your ticket is at Will Call, and we will handle those on a one-off basis. If your tickets are not at Will Call, you must show them at the Check-In area to enter the stadium.
- SPECTATORS: Please keep walkways clear, and proceed directly into the stands to alleviate congestion and allow teams the space they need.
- Bathrooms will be available on the concourse at midfield for spectators
- Games on the field:
 - Once your game is over, please make an effort to leave the stadium field as quickly as possible so that the next games may begin on time.
 - Players and coaches can meet up with their families back at the Check-In table area, and should feel free to return to the stadium to cheer on other teams from Gillette Stadium seating, visit Patriot Place (<http://www.patriot-place.com/>), or head back to Lot 6A or 6B to get ready for the tailgate depending on when your game ends (tailgating will not begin until 4:30, but you are allowed in the parking lot before then.)
 - Water bottles will be permitted on the field, and there will be water coolers on the field in case your players need refills. There is NO food or drinks allowed in the stands.
 - Players can wear cleats or indoor soccer shoes (the surface is field turf).
 - Wear your team uniforms
 - Please remember these are friendly games and should be about the experience of playing on the Gillette Stadium field. Games will be 35 minutes apiece.
- Additional Notes:
 - **DISCOUNTED TICKETS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE DAY OF GAME.** If you need additional tickets on the day of the game, they will be full price at the ticket office.
 - During the 40th minute of the Revs game, your organization's name will scroll on the Gillette Stadium Matrix Board. Look for it and cheer on your organization.

- The best place to get autographs after the game is in Autograph Alley. This is located right where you will be checking in for your games on the field (Patriot Place Plaza, under the bridge). 4 or more Revolution players will sign autographs immediately following the game for 20 minutes
- General Timeline: Below is a general timeline for the day:

-2:00 pm – Parking Lots 6A and 6B open (NO TAILGATING allowed until 4:30pm)
-2:30 pm – Check-in opens for games on Gillette Stadium field at the Patriot Place gate
-2:45 pm – First series of games begin
-3:20 pm – First games end
-3:25 pm – Second series of games begin
-4:00 pm – Second games end
-4:05 pm – Third series of games begin
-4:40 pm – Third games end
-4:45 pm – Fourth series of games begin
-5:20 pm – Final games end
-5:30 pm - Stadium must be cleared of all participants

-4:30 pm - Tailgating may begin in parking lots
-6:30 pm - Stadium gates open for the game
-7:30 pm - Kick-off (New England Revolution vs. Philadelphia Union)
-Autograph Alley will be open after the game
