Due to the nature of today's Games on the Field event, we are allowing players to bring their sports bags into the stadium after they have been searched by security.

However, please note that when you arrive back at the NRG Plaza gates to enter for tonight's match, these bags will NOT be allowed in.

Gillette Stadium has enacted a **"clear bag policy"** for all stadium events.

In accordance with Gillette Stadium Security Guidelines, the only bags, packages, or containers permitted to be carried by fans as they approach the stadium are the following:



Bags that are not in compliance will not be stored and must be returned to your vehicle.

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to: purses larger than a small clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, diaper bags, non-approved seat cushions (including large traditional seat cushions that have pockets, zippers, compartments or covers), luggage of any kind, computer bags and camera bags or any bag larger than the permissible size.

Prior to reaching the metal detectors for screening at all stadium gates, fans are asked to remove phones and cameras from their pockets to expedite the screening process. Unlike procedures fans may be familiar with at the airport, stadium security will not ask fans to remove loose change or keys from their pockets and they won't need to remove their shoes or belts.
