Camp Highlights:

Training Sessions:

The first instructional session will be a technical session geared to help players improve their techniques of dribbling, passing, shooting, and receiving. The second session will be a tactical session geared to help players improve their decision making within game settings. Instruction will focus on attacking and defending in 1v1 through 2v2 situations.

Little Soccer Hornets (ages 5-6):

Campers will learn soccer skills through fun games and soccer activities. This is a half day camp only.

For ages 7-8 - We offer a half day and a full day option for this age group.

Pre High School Training:

Pre High School aged (entering 8th-9th grade) campers with advanced skills will be challenged through more advanced technical and tactical soccer activities and games. The training will help prepare them for what they will experience at the high school level.

High School Training:

Advanced technical and tactical training geared to the experienced high school player. Small side and large sided games are used to promote learning and development of the individual player as well as application in a team setting.

Camp Staff

Kevin Smith - Camp Director:

Coach Smith is in his 5th year as Varsity Girls Soccer Coach at Mansfield High School. His teams have earned 3 straight MIAA tournament berths, 2 straight 3rd place finishes in the league and 2 straight Hockomock League Sportsmanship Awards. The 2006 team achieved the best Hockomock League record in MHS history and finished 9-4-4 for 3rd place in the league. The 2006 team also earned the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Team Academic Award with an overall team GPA of 3.47. As a college player at Trenton State College (now The College of New Jersey), his teams appeared in 1 NCAA Final, 2 NCAA Final Fours, 3 NCAA Regional Finals and won the NJAC League Title in 1994. Coach Smith earned the NCAA-Adidas Regional Academic All-American award in 1994. Coach Smith holds the NSCAA Advanced National Coaching Diploma and a USSF National license.

Denis Cutler - Staff Coach & Co-Director

Coach Culter is the girls varsity soccer coach at Millis High School. He holds a USSF A license and the NSCAA Premier Diploma. Coach Cutler has coached various club and Olympic Development teams (ODP) and has won the Massachusetts State Cup with 2 of his club teams. Coach Cutler is also on the Massachusetts Youth Soccer State Instructional Staff.

James Carver-Brown - Staff Coach

Coach Carver-Brown is a USSF C licensed coach and has been the JV Girls soccer coach at Mansfield High School for four years. He has worked with youth in Walpole for a number of years. Coach Carver-Brown is a licensed referee.

Kaitlyn Rea - Staff Coach

Coach Rea is in her 3rd year as the assistant varsity Girls Soccer Coach at Mansfield High School. She played both soccer and basketball at Framingham State College.
