Coach Enoch holds a USSF National "D" License. Additionally, he has played as a goalkeeper at the professional level.



Coach Mark Vermont is the head coach for the Lynnfield High School Girls' Varsity team. He has lead his team to back-to-back State championships in 2003 and 2004. He was named Eastern Mass Division III Girls Coach of the Year in 2003, 2004, 2008 and 2013.

Coach Vermont has also coached a U16 and U14 girls' club team, for the NESS organization. He holds a USSF National "D" and a NSCAA National License. Coach Vermont played goalkeeper at Gordon College and has extensive experience training young goalkeepers.
