XIII. MAKE UP GAMES

The agreement on a mutually acceptable time and date for the replay of a game that was a valid postponement must be reached by the teams involved within two (2) weeks of the date when the game was postponed and the date of the rescheduled game must be within four (4) weeks of postponed game.

- Size 4 ball
- 25 minute halves
- YES: Offsides, Goalie punts, no 2nd chance throw-ins
- Coaches must have passcard and CORI form (on lanyard)
- Player passcards not required
- Must have 2 approved rosters on gameday, numbers need to match player!

U12: WBES and WCES (lower)

- 9 v 9
- Size 4 ball
- 30 minute halves
- YES: Offsides, Goalie punts, no 2nd chance throw-ins
- Coaches must have passcard and CORI form (on lanyard)
- Player passcards required for D2, NOT for D3
- Must have 2 approved rosters on gameday, numbers need to match player!



U14/16: Quaboag

- 11 v 11
- Size 5 ball
- 35 (u14), 40 (u16) minute halves
- YES: Offsides, Goalie punts, no 2nd chance throw-ins
- Coaches must have passcard and CORI form (on lanyard)
- Player passcards required
- Must have 2 approved rosters on gameday, numbers need to match player!



U12+ Post-Season

D3 teams:

- Gaffney Cup June 9/10
- 2 games in one day
- Fined if we do not play!

D2+ teams:

- Playoffs June 9/10, if teams make it based on record
- Win playoffs, go to MTOC
