Coaches Code of Conduct



Coach's Code of Conduct

The Board of Directors of Massachusetts Youth Soccer Association, Incorporated (Mass Youth Soccer) and the leaders of the affiliated Leagues are concerned about the conduct of all coaches and referees during games at all levels, from recreational to premier to ODP. We want to ensure that games are fair, positive and enjoyable experiences for all of the children and adults involved. A soccer game should be friendly and unifying - a spirited social and athletic occasion for players, coaches, referees and spectators.

To clarify expectations of coach conduct, we jointly expect all coaches to conform to this code of conduct.

- Before, during and after the game, be an example of dignity, patience and positive spirit.
- Before a game, introduce yourself to the opposing coach and to the referee.
- During the game, you are responsible for the sportsmanship of your players. If one of your players is disrespectful, irresponsible or overly aggressive, take the player out of the game at least long enough for him/her to calm down.
- During the game, you are also responsible for the conduct of the parents of your players. It is imperative to explain acceptable player and parent behavior in a preseason meeting.
- Encourage them to applaud and cheer for good plays by either team. Discourage them and you may need to be forceful and direct from yelling at players and the referee.
- During the game, you are also responsible for the conduct of spectators rooting for your team.
- During the game, do not address the referee at all. If you have a small issue, discuss it with the referee calmly and patiently after the game.
- If you have a major complaint, or if you think the referee was unfair, biased, unfit or incompetent, report your opinion to your League. Your reactions will be taken seriously if they are presented objectively and formally.
- After the game, thank the referee and ask your players to do the same.

We stress two points: Referees - especially young and inexperienced ones - are like your players and yourself, in that they need time to develop. You can play an important role in helping them to improve by letting them concentrate on the game. You can help by encouraging them, by accepting their inevitable, occasional mistakes and by offering constructive post-game comments. On the other hand, you could discourage and demoralize the referees by criticizing their decisions, by verbally abusing them and inciting - or even accepting - your own players' overly aggressive behavior. Your example is powerful, for better or worse. If you insist on fair play, if you concentrate on your players' enjoyment of the game and their overall, long term development, and if you support the referee, your players and their parents will notice. If you encourage (or allow) your players to play outside the rules, if you're overly concerned about results, and if you criticize the referee harshly, your players and their parents will also notice.

Think about what you're doing during a game! Uphold the Spirit of the Game! If you follow the expectations described above, the spirit of the game will be alive and well in Massachusetts and will grow, along with the enjoyment of all.

Coaches who don't follow the expectations described above will be disciplined or removed

MA Youth Soccer Sept 1 Guidance



- If a player or coach is contact-traced and identified as a close contact in a setting other than a soccer related event, this should be reported to the COVID-19 Safety Officer (President & Vice President) by the coach or the player's parent/guardian.
 - The player/coach is to follow the quarantine process provided to them by the DPH and/or by the school nurse. A player can return to soccer activities on the return date issued by DPH or their school. If the date is provided by the school, a player should return to soccer on the same day they can return to school and under the same guidelines.
 - The remainder of the team can continue to practice as normal.
 - Massachusetts Youth Soccer does not need to be notified in this case.
 - If at any time during their quarantine period, any member of the team (including coach or staff) tests positive for COVID-19, the Safety officer should be notified.
 - Timelines will be reported and discussed by the Safety Officer with the DPH at that time.
 - Notification of the team and any opposing team will be based on recommendations by the DPH in accordance with current CDC recommendations.
- If the team is asked to quarantine, reporting procedures as outlined in the Notification section of the Massachusetts Youth Soccer Website should be followed.
 - Massachusetts Youth Soccer should be notified of the positive case.
 - Member organizations should be prepared to shut down and stop operations if instructed to do so by the local Board of Health.
 - Develop plans for temporary closure of facilities (indoor, outdoor) to properly disinfect and ensure other adult leaders are not infected.

RYS COVID Overview



- Currently, participants and spectators are not required to wear face coverings for outdoor soccer activities, but face coverings may be worn at the discretion of a player's parent/guardian. If a face covering is worn on the field of play, it must be an ear loop-style mask.
- We will continue to follow the quarantine protocols established by the Wachusett Regional School District. (https://docs.google.com/document/d/1O2zQL-s2WhCQrVTubmLgMRSnZyxH27a_uMgNBZaprDk/edit)
- In general, if your child does not feel well enough to attend school then please keep them out of soccer activities until they feel well enough to return to school.
- Please do not attend soccer activities if your child is not permitted at school due to COVID symptoms, COVID exposure, or a positive COVID test.
- When your child returns to school then they are welcome to return to soccer activities.
- Please alert your coach and/or a RYS administrator if your child has potential COVID exposure or a positive COVID test.
 - If a coach is notified, you must notify the RYS President & Vice President

COVID Modifications to the Game



- There are currently no COVID-19 related modifications to the game
- Soccer will be played as it should be

Attendance Logs



- Taking attendance at all Massachusetts Youth Soccer events is important as it provides us with the ability to notify participants and their families in the event of a confirmed positive case of COVID-19. Contact tracing helps protect our players their families and our soccer community by:
 - Letting people know they may have been exposed to COVID-19 and should monitor their health for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
 - Helping people who may have been exposed to COVID-19 get tested.
 - Asking people to self-isolate if they have COVID-19 or self-quarantine if they are a close contact.
 - Helps Public Health Departments to identify a possible COVID-19 cluster.
- It is necessary to have updated parent contact information in the event COVID notification must be sent to your team.
- For all outdoor soccer activities Massachusetts Youth Soccer requires attendance logs be kept for all players, coaches, referees and other onsite administrators.
- As a Coach, this is your responsibility. Keep track of who is at every practice, game and team gathering that you have

BY-LAWS

Rev. November 22, 2020

- I. LEAGUE AFFILIATION The League will affiliate with the United States Youth Soccer Association (U.S.Y.S.A.), the Massachusetts Youth Soccer Association (Mass Youth), the United States Soccer Federation (U.S.S.F.) and the Federation International De Football Association (F.I.F.A.). Rules of all will be in effect.

III. PLAYER, TEAM & CLUB ELIGIBILITY



- A. Players listed on the roster shall have a residency requirement as noted in section XXX. More than one team maybe entered by each club.
- B. All players must be registered with the League registrars. NO PLAYER MAY PRACTICE UNTIL REGISTERED WITH MASS YOUTH SOCCER AND NO PLAYER MAY PLAY ANY LEAGUE GAME UNTIL REGISTERED WITH M.A.Y.S. No player may be rostered on or play for more than one (1) MTOC-eligible team entered in the M.A.Y.S. League.
- C. Rosters of teams are to be submitted to the registrar according to the registration procedures. No team will be allowed to play without being registered in advance....

Division III teams may roster as many players as they wish.

Division I and II teams have roster limits.

IV. LENGTH OF GAMES, OVERTIME PERIODS, BALL SIZES



The length of games, over-time play and ball sizes for each age group are:

Age Group	Game Length	Playoff Over-Time	Ball Size
Under 19	Two 45 Minute Halves	Two 10 Minute Halves	5
Under 18	Two 45 Minute Halves	Two 10 Minute Halves	5
Under 18 (Fall)	Two 40 Minute Halves	Not Applicable	5
Under 16	Two 40 Minute Halves	Two 10 Minute Halves	5
Under 14	Two 35 Minute Halves	Two 5 Minute Halves	5
Under 12	Two 30 Minute Halves	Two 5 Minute Halves	4
Under 10	Two 25 Minute Halves	Not Applicable	4

Playoff Overtime is NOT based upon Golden Goal format. Both overtime halves must be played through to completion. If the game remains tied at the conclusion of both overtime periods, then the game will be decided using Kicks from the Penalty Mark according to FIFA. **There are no playoffs during the fall season.**

Play shall be suspended and all participants shall seek shelter when lightning is 6 miles distant, or closer. (In estimating distance of a lightning strike, use the "flash to bang" method. Count the seconds from the time lightning is sighted, until the accompanying thunderclap is heard. If the time is 30 seconds or less, the distance is 6 miles or less.) Before resuming play, wait 30 minutes after the last lightning strike within the 6 mile limit. In the event that a game is terminated, it will be considered complete providing that the first half has been completed.

V. SUBSTITUTIONS



The number of substitutions is unlimited. They may be made, with the consent of the referee, at the following times:

1. Prior to a throw-in in your favor, or a throw-in for the opposing team if BOTH teams have players ready to enter the game.
2. Prior to a goal kick by either team.
3. After a goal by either team.
4. After an injury when the referee stops play.
5. At Half-time.

Substitutions are NOT allowed at corner kicks or free kicks.

The ref MUST acknowledge your desire to sub prior to your subs entering the field of play

IX. PLAYER'S EQUIPMENT



Uniforms must consist of matching shirts with unique numbers, matching shorts, matching socks, shin guards and suitable soccer shoes or sneakers. Baseball cleats, football cleats and metal cleats are not allowed.

Undergarments such as cycling shorts may be worn as allowed per rules published by U.S.S.F. in the Guide for Referees and Mass Youth. The colors shall be selected at the option of the team. In the case of a clash of colors, the home team is responsible for changing or wearing pinnies.

Players are not allowed to play with any dangerous equipment; including jewelry, casts, hard brimmed hats.

XI. TIMING AND FORFEIT OF GAME



Referee and teams must be present at the field 15 minutes prior to the scheduled kick-off time. If the referee does not arrive within 15 minutes after the scheduled time, he/she may not receive any fee. In this case, the coaches of the two teams will appoint an acting referee and play the game. If a mutually acceptable party cannot be found to act as referee, the game must be rescheduled. In the event of a team being late, the other team must report it to the League for appropriate action.

If either team has not arrived within 15 minutes after the scheduled time, the referee will leave the field, and will receive payment. In this case, the missing team will forfeit the game.

XII. POSTPONEMENTS



The only legitimate reasons for postponing a game are:

1. Bad weather at the site of the game.
2. Vandalism to the field or field is unavailable. It is suggested that teams swap fields to play the game.
3. Reschedule requests must be submitted to the MAYS President by the Club/Town Rep. Reschedule requests for games during the first 2 weeks of the season must be received by the MAYS President one week prior to the game date. All other reschedule requests for games beyond week 3 must be received no later than 7 days after the first date of games for the age group of the teams impacted by the request. Only one request per team will be allowed. The acceptable reasons for requesting a reschedule is for school event, religious event which prevents a team from fielding the minimum number of required players...

It is the responsibility of the home team to notify both the visiting team coach and the referee assignor of the postponement at least two hours before the scheduled game time.

ONLY the RYS Board can close a field or cancel a game

Coaches CANNOT cancel a game

Once at the field, ONLY a referee can cancel a game

XIII. MAKE UP GAMES



The agreement on a mutually **acceptable time and date** for the replay of a game that was a valid postponement must be **reached by the teams involved within two (2) weeks** of the date when the game was postponed and the **date of the rescheduled game must be within four (4) weeks of postponed game**. Notwithstanding the afore defined requirement, **the last available date for making up any postponed game shall be the last day of the regular playing season** as specified in the published schedule except with special consideration and prior consent given by the President. Failure to reschedule and play a makeup game in accordance with this By-Law shall result in the President determining if any or neither team shall be awarded a forfeit.

If a mutually suitable time for a make-up game can not be agreed upon by the coaches within the time limit stated above, the home team must immediately provide to the President three (3) reasonable game times which are on different dates and within the time limits as stated above. The visiting team must then accept one of these dates or forfeit the game. If alternative game times/dates submitted by the home team are deemed unreasonable by the President, then the President will give the visiting team three (3) dates to choose from within the stated time limit and may schedule the game at the visiting team's field or at a neutral site.

XVI. SCORES



Scores, ref evaluations and game information will be entered and record using the software the MAYS board uses to run the League by the coach. Score corrections/updates to be handled by the MAYS Vice President.

More information on this will be discussed later in this presentation.

XVII. BALLS



Home teams will provide a minimum of two regulation balls -- per U.S.Y.S.A. standards.

You will be provided two game balls. Both game balls should be given to the referee prior to the start of all home games.

XXIII. GAME DAY ROSTERS



Each coach will provide TWO copies of the team roster with visible water mark approved by M.A.Y.S. to the referee before the start of each game. Failure to do so will result in a \$25 fine to the club for an un-verified roster and/or game forfeiture, and \$50 fine to the club for no roster and/or game forfeiture. Rosters must be generated through the MAYS specified rostering system, such as SportsManager. If the game doesn't get played as a regular game because of the above if it's the away team, they will also be charged the ref fee's so it can be given to the home team. If it was the home team they will only get the fine. A maximum of three coaches are allowed at the bench area.

XXIV. PASS CARDS



Coaches pass card are not required if the coach's picture and information is on the Approved roster. All players' pictures are required in all divisions, and must be up-to-date on the Approved roster. The Mass Youth Soccer CORI ID is required for all coaches.

Referees will not allow a game to proceed without a registered coach possessing a valid CORI ID present for each team and coach. If the game is allowed to be played without the players' and/or coaches' Approved roster, the game may be subject to forfeiture. The MAYS league must make the decision within 2 weeks and notify the town representative. If no decision is made within the 2-week period, then the result stands.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY



All persons responsible for a team and all of the spectators shall support the referee. Coaches are responsible for the team's spectators and shall address any issue with spectator who is interfering with the match. Should the referee stop play and request the coach to dismiss the spectator the coach will do so or the match will be abandoned. Failure to do so will undermine the referee's authority and has the potential of creating a hostile environment for players, the referee and all other participants and spectators.

Consequently, the MAYS League has adopted the following rule:

No one is to address the referee during the Match!

Exceptions for persons responsible for a team (Coaches and Managers)

During the Game

1. Responding to a referee initiating communication.
2. Making Substitutions
3. Pointing out emergencies or safety issues

At Half Time or the End of the Match

1. A coach/manager can ask a referee to explain a rule(s) in a polite and constructive manner.
2. Polite and friendly feedback can be given to a referee.
3. Absolutely NO sarcasm, harassment or intimidation.

XXX. SPORTSMANSHIP



B. Goal Scoring

Any team that has a **differential score of 8 or more goals** will receive a warning for the first offense. Second offense will result in the coach being suspended for one game and the town will be fined \$150. Next occurrence will result in the coach being suspended for eight (8) games and the town will be fined \$150.

From RYS: How to Avoid This

- Have your team stop scoring if you get to a 5-goal differential
- Add more players to your defensive line and reduce the number of offensive players
- If you have weaker players, put them on offense, and tell your team they are the only player that is allowed to shoot
- Quietly, without making a big deal out of it, reduce the number of players you have on the field
- You may decide to sit your stronger players
- There are no playoffs in the fall season, so goal differential has no bearing. This must not be a coach ego thing to get as many goals as possible. Use it as a training opportunity for your team (i.e. must complete 6 passes without the other team touching the ball before shooting)
- Explain this concept to your team and parents so they all understand if you end up in this situation



RUTLAND YOUTH SOCCER ADMINISTRATIVE

- Show up at least 30 minutes prior to every game.
- Ask parents to show up at least 30 minutes before every game.
 - Parents will get lost, officials & opposing coaches may have questions, etc.

Where Do I Get Equipment



Rutland Youth Soccer Provides:

- Uniforms to all players (shorts, jersey, socks)
- Coach equipment bag with the following items:
 - Game Balls
 - Small Cones
 - Whistle
 - Ball Pump
 - Goalie Jersey
 - First Aid Kit
 - Large Cones
 - Pinnies
 - Extra Ball Pump Needles
 - Goalie Gloves
 - Ice Packs

Ask all your players to bring a ball to practice. Most kids at U10 and above now have an appropriate ball

Home team must provide & wear pinnies if jersey color is the same or ref deems them to be too close in color

Check with the RYS Equipment Coordinator if additional equipment is needed.

GAME ROSTERS

- You MUST bring 2 copies of your signed, "APPROVED" roster to every game. Sign your roster under the Coach's Signature section on the bottom.
- Your team will not be allowed to play without the rosters. RYS will receive a fine for the forfeiture.
- Do NOT add players to your rosters. Players can only be added by the RYS registrar.
- Warm up your team and set up your roster based upon players who arrive for play.
- You must add jersey numbers to roster, either by hand or through sports manager – the ref is not responsible for doing this

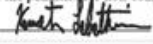
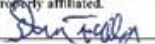
