Coach/Assistant Coach Responsibilities:

- Must complete MYSA Adult Membership Form and required CORI information and supply to Travel Director.
- Distribute SSYSL forms and league info.
- Notify parents of important dates
- Conduct no less than 1 and no more than 3 practices per week
- Collect all league equipment at the end of the Season
- Assure that trash is picked up after the game/practice
- Will not cancel or re-schedule a game directly with the opposing coach. Must follow SCSL rules with regards to cancellations / reschedules.
- Will not allow a player to train or play prior to a completed registrations form for the player being submitted to the SSYSL Registrar.
- Coaches using unregistered players can be suspended immediately.
- Will require their team to wear the designated SSYSL team uniform to all games and tournaments using SSYSL's club/team name.
- Will support the referees as described in the Rules of Play in section "Support for Referees (Zero Tolerance Policy)"
- Will be responsible for all their player's parents' conduct at all team events.
- Coaches are to coach the games from the same sideline that the players are sitting on (bench) and remain in the bench area.
- Coaches/Parents are not allowed to coach the players from the parent's sideline or on the end line (behind the goals).
- Coaches will follow the rules with regards to recording scores and reporting "cards" in the SCSL website.

COACH CERTIFICATION

- i) I certify that I will comply with MYS and SSYSL Bylaws, Rules of Play and Coach's Code of Conduct, and understand that there are penalties for non-compliance. Coaches MUST read and understand the Bylaws and Rules of Play which are posted on our league website at www.ssysl.net or you can ask the Travel Director of SSYSL for a copy.
- ii) Coaches will participate in only sanctioned/approved games and tournaments of Massachusetts Youth Soccer.
- iii) Coaches will only participate in games, training sessions or tournaments outside of the state of Massachusetts if they have completed and have an approved Permission to Travel Out of State Form from Massachusetts Youth Soccer.
- iv) **Coaches are required to have all of their players registration forms with the Consent for Medical Treatment with them at all training sessions, practices, scrimmages, games & tournament events. It's recommended that these are stored in a water proof package/container.**
