- 1) All coaches must complete this form in order to be registered for this upcoming season & include a PHOTO COPY of your DRIVER'S LICENSE that must be hand delivered at scheduled SSYSL Coaching Registration sessions (TBA) or to your Division Director. The Coaching Qualifications Director or Division Director must review the photo copy of your license to ensure that the ID & photo is indeed you; however, you may redact your license number.
- 2) ALL COACHES need to register and complete their CORI with Mass Youth Soccer (MYS) at <http://ma-adultinfo.affinitysoccer.com/mbrsite/mbrsite.aspx?siteguid=92FAC7CB-3EA3-4A52-89D6-1FA0EC6DF027>. RETURNING COACHES need to check their CORI expiration date, since it cannot expire before 31 NOV 2018.
- 3) All coaches must upload a HEADSHOT ONLY for the digital photo. Any pictures that have backgrounds or family included will be deleted. When completed, you must print your CORI Agreement form and return it one of our coaching registrations. RETURNING COACHES will be notified if your CORI has expired.
- 4) ALL NEW COACHES & NEW ASSISTANT COACHES must complete the Heads Up Course training video at <https://heads-up.cdc.gov>. When you complete training, please e-mail training certificate to the following e-mail address: coachingqualificationsdirector@gmail.com.

Coach / Assistant Coach Responsibilities:

- Must complete MYSA Coach's Membership Form and submit to Director.
- Must complete the MYSA online CORI Check electronic form and be cleared from MYS in order to coach/interact with the children.
- Agree to comply with Playing Time Requirement listed in the Rules of Play:
 - Each player must play at least half (50%) of a complete game unless hurt or if they receive penalties. It's recommended that every player should be allowed to play the same amount of time over the season so that the weaker players can become better and the more advanced players can continue to develop their skills.
 - Pre-K to Gr. 7+: No player is allowed to play four (4) quarters of any game, unless all of the other players on that team have played at least three (3) quarters.
- Distribute SSYSL forms and league info., including notifying parents of important dates.
- Conduct no less than one (1) and no more than three (3) practices per week.
- Collect all league equipment at the end of the season.
- Assure that trash is picked up after the game/practice.
- Will not re-schedule a game, unless the age group director has given prior approval.
- Can't recruit players, as all new registrations must go to the Registrar before player can be allowed to play.
- Coaches using unregistered players will be suspended immediately.
- Must know and abide by the MYSA & SSYSL coaches' rules of conduct.
- Will sign all appropriate forms, including acknowledgment of the above at coaches meeting held prior to the start of the season.
- Will pass out and require their team to wear the designated team shirt that has been assigned/given out by the Director to all games.
- Will support the referees as described in the Rules of Play in section "Support for Referees (Zero Tolerance Policy)".
- Will be responsible for all their player's parents' conduct at the game.
- Coaches are to coach the games from the same sideline that the players are sitting on (bench), except for the lower age groups as stated in the Rules of Play.
- Coaches/Parents are not allowed to coach the players from the parent's sideline or on the end line (behind the goals).
- Coaches are asked to keep the scores of games within five (5) goals. They should be making adjustments to the lineup/positions that players are playing or placing parameters on how their team is to score additional goals such as only shooting from outside the penalty or shooting on goal from a cross pass to keep the score relatively close.
