1. Please fill out application and mail with **check made out to Sutton Public Schools**.
2. Applications and **checks are due by the Friday before the start of each camp** to avoid a late fee.
3. Additional sign-ups will be accepted on the morning of the 1st day of camp that week. **Note: A \$10 per camper late fee will be added to the cost of the camp.**
4. In order to properly staff camps, applications are appreciated ASAP.
5. Lunch (pizza), snacks and drinks will be available for purchase daily. **Campers may bring their own lunches.**
6. Balls and equipment will be provided for all camps. If possible, campers should bring their own sport specific equipment. (ex. gloves, racquets, etc.)

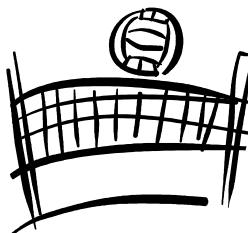
