To: Michelle Khan and Shakeel Khan parents of Imran Khan

The Travel Disciplinary Board per Woburn Youth Soccer Association Board of Directors has reviewed reports pertaining to the following games:

- PG Boys Game #27124 Woburn Athletics vs Topsfield Masco Chieftains that took place in N. Andover on Field # 8 on May 1, 2022 at 2:45 PM

Reports state that Imran Khan was issued a Red Card for Violent Conduct (Head Butt) after Woburn was award direct kick for a foul committed by Topsfield.

- PG Boys Game #27121 Woburn Athletics vs North Andover Red Storm that took place in Merrimack on Pentucket Field 4 on April 24, 2022 at 2:45 PM

Reports state that Imran Khan was issued a Yellow Card for Unsporting Behavior (Slide Tackle w/ cleats up) towards the N. Andover goalkeeper after a save was made.

Based on these reports, WYS takes the following actions effective immediately:

- Player Imran Khan is suspended for 2 games (May 8 & May 15, 2022) for being shown a red card during the game and per ECYSA Disciplinary Board.
- Additionally, the Travel Disciplinary Board per WYS is suspending Player Imran Khan for the remainder of the Spring 2022 season and all post-season games for serious violent conduct on another player & conduct unbecoming.

Game suspensions to be served May 8,2022 through June 30, 2022.

Imran Khan may appeal this decision per WYS Rules as set forth in Section XXVI Players Code of Conduct.
