

# Moniteau Youth Baseball and Softball Association Constitution (REV.1)

## Article I – Name

Moniteau Youth Baseball and Softball Association (a nonprofit Organization 501c3) shall be known as:

Moniteau youth Baseball and Softball association hereinafter known as “league”.

## Article II – Statement of policy

The Moniteau Baseball and Softball Association endeavors to develop through a program which is conducive to the development of positive values amongst its participants. Among these values are a desire for self-development, recognition of the need for order, an understanding of working together, and an acquisition of fundamental knowledge of the game of baseball and softball. From these values should cultivate a positive athletic and social experience.

## Article III – Mission

The purpose of the League shall be to organize, promote, and supervise the playing of youth baseball and softball under specialized rules and regulations, to secure suitable and adequate financial backing for these purposes, to promote good sportsmanship, and to own, lease, or otherwise provide suitable playing facilities and equipment for these purposes.

## Article IV – Membership

4.1 This League shall be open to any eligible child, regardless of gender, religion, race, or disability. The only regulations shall be the age limits as determined in the Bylaws and the willingness of the parent/guardian to perform duties as described in the Bylaws.

4.2 Members shall be defined as any player over the age of 18 and the parents of any player who within the previous 12 months has completed registration to play baseball or softball with the Moniteau youth baseball and Softball Association.

## Article V – Board of Directors

**The Board of Directors** shall consist of five elected officers and four board directors, 1 alternate non voting board member. This Board of Directors shall be nominated from the community and the Membership in the manner provided for in the Bylaws of the League. An Election for the officers and board will be held each year at an annual meeting or event. The terms and manner for elections will be provided in the Bylaws of the League.

## Article VI – Officers

The officers shall consist of President, Vice President of Baseball, Vice president of softball, Treasurer and Secretary.

## Article VII – Government

7.1 The government of the league shall be under the direct supervision of the Officers and Board Directors.

7.2 All rules governing the playing of baseball and softball and the legality of players and related questions shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

## Article VIII – Amendments and Dissolution

8.1 This Constitution may be amended by 2/3 vote of the Board of Directors at a Special Constitutional Amendment Meeting called for that purpose. A Special Constitutional Amendment Meeting shall only be called by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

8.2 This Constitution may be dissolved for the purpose of creating a new Constitution or new League by 2/3 vote of the Board of Directors at a Special Constitutional Dissolution Meeting called for that Purpose. A Special Dissolution Meeting shall only be called by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

8.3 In the event of dissolution, any remaining assets after all statutory requirements, legal obligations, and outstanding debts have been paid shall be donated to:
